

Dear Parents,

CORONAVIRUS/COVID 19 UPDATE

Further to my letter of Thursday 12 March, I am now giving you a further update on our school position in the event of a forthcoming closure. Today all children are bringing home with them a pack of work which they can work through at home if we are instructed to close. With the packs teachers are providing a clear guide to parents on what work to complete, where to record your work and how to set your work out. Work will be completed on worksheets, in study books and also recorded in Maths and English homework books. Packs are in addition to online learning. Please remember to clearly date all work completed.

We have set up a designated page on our school website for covid-19 updates which I hope parents will find helpful. This will contain medical updates from Public Health England, latest updates from the Government and DfE with regard to schools and advice for families on how to reduce children's anxiety around the virus. We will also be posting on this page education links for parents which will contain free resources and activities from various publishers and children's education providers for children's home learning. If there is an extended period of closure, additional work will be posted on the class pages on the website.

I am currently working with our school technician and we are in the process of setting up temporary e-mail accounts for all teaching staff. Staff will be happy to receive questions/queries from parents during working hours throughout any closure. These e-mail contacts will cease to exist once schools return to normal. I will inform you of the contact details as soon as these accounts have been set up.

Thank you to all parents for returning the data forms. We have the vast majority of these now returned and updated, if you have still not returned your form I urge you to return it to the school office without delay to ensure we have the right emergency contact details for you.

I will write again to parents to update you further as soon as I am in a position to do so. Assuring you of my very best attention at all times and particularly during this difficult time of uncertainty and anxiety amongst families, our community and country.
