We have had a busy week in Year 2 as we work our way through the 'Touch The Future' curriculum that we follow in St Oswald's. We have been learning and honing our skills across the subjects. Here is a snippet of what we have been working on:

## English:

We have been continuing with our class book of 'Jack and the baked beanstalk'. Here you can see Jack (Amber) walking down a conscious alley with the children trying to convince him (her) to either climb up the beanstalk or not.



Art:

The children were continuing with their focus on the formal elements of art. Here they can be seen learning how to draw a piece of ribbon in a 3D style.



Maths:

We have continued to learn about place value this week, with a focus on greater than and less than. Here the children are demonstrating their understanding through use of physical objects and numbers.



Science:

Today we did an investigation of materials. The children were given a dilemma of how to keep mice out of a house, which material would be best to stop the mice from chewing through. They had four different materials and they had to see which was the most difficult to scratch or even make a hole in. We determined that the best option was to actually get a cat!
