

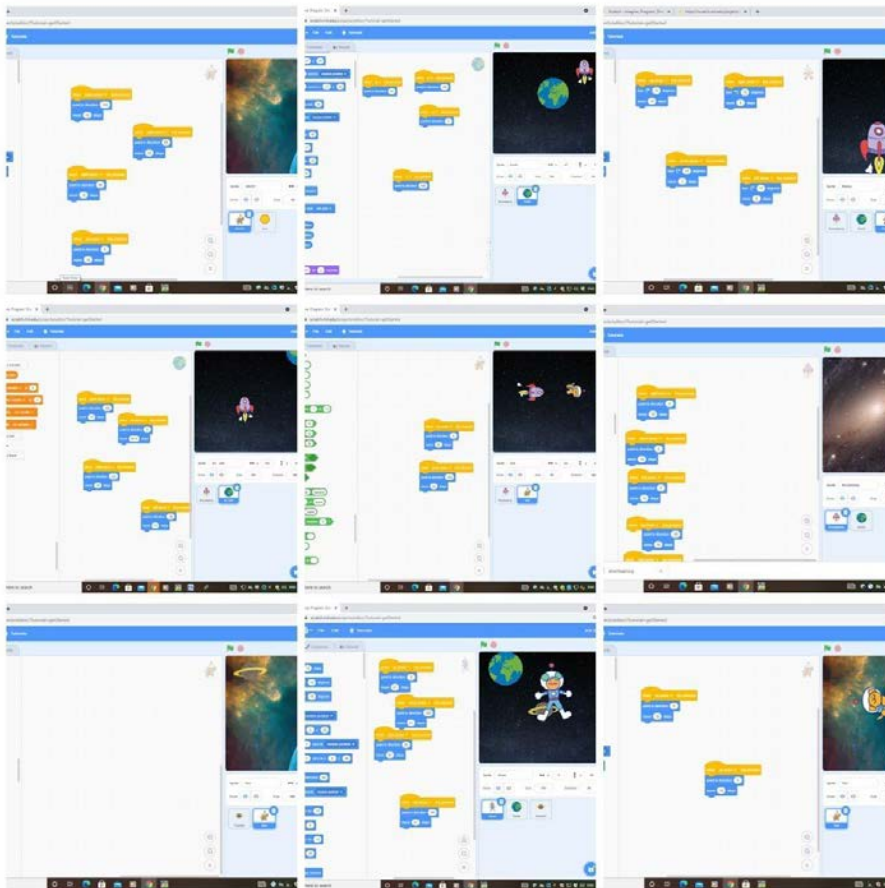
# St Oswald's Year 2: Weekly Update

## Computing:

This week in computing the children have been using Scratch to create programmes that can allow an object to move depending on which key is pressed. They based it around a rocket flying through space. Some of the children even managed to programme two objects and turn it into a game of cat and mouse!



Art:

This week the children have been continuing learning about human form. They have been using photos of themselves to break down into different features before reassembling them!



PE:

The class has started to move from dynamic movement towards static balance in PE. Here you can see some of the children having fun seeing how many objects they can hold whilst holding a static balance!

We have started our new topic in RE this week called signs and symbols. In order to explore it as a topic we went around the school to see how many signs and symbols we could find!
