

Year 3 Class News 27/9/21 – 1/10/21

We've had another busy but exciting week in Year 3. We continued with our Stone Age to Iron Age topic and explored how people survived and fended for themselves. We went out into the school gardens foraging and behaving like hunter gatherers. We used the berries and twigs we had found in the garden to make paint for our Stone Age cave paintings.

In Science we have been learning about what scientists do. This week we have looked at the Scientific method and what it means to complete a 'fair test'. We began our first experiment and recorded the steps involved but will have to wait for a whole week before we can gather our results!

We've loved listening to lots of Fables over the past few weeks and our learning has culminated with us writing our own fable. We first had to think of a moral or a lesson and then plan and write a fable which included conjunctions and direct speech. We had some great ideas, produced some super work and enjoyed sharing them. It was lovely to see the children stand up and confidently present their work to their classmates. Children have also enjoyed our Guided Reading sessions where they have the chance to work independently or in small groups and spend time enjoying books in the class library.

Next week we will be starting a new maths topic on addition and subtraction. In RE we will learn about Judaism.
