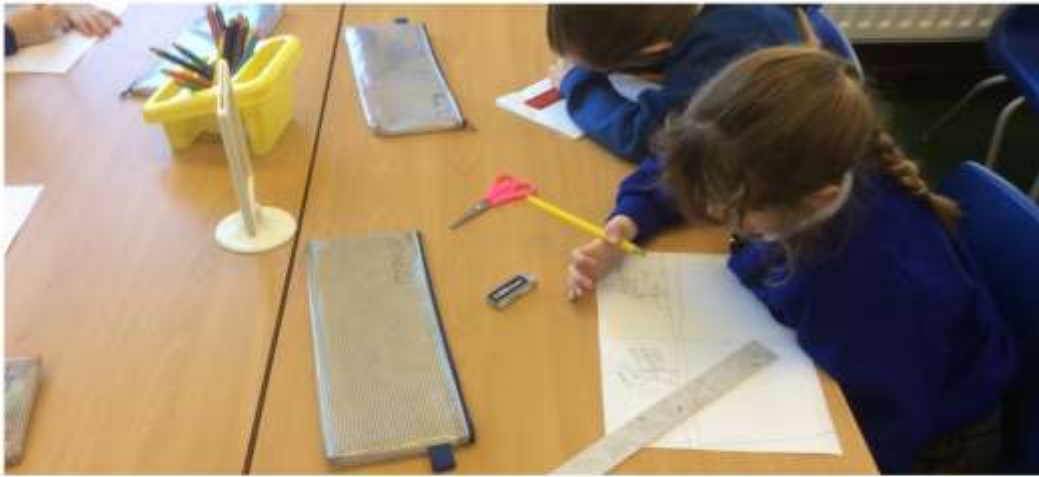


PE:
