The weeks are whizzing by but we are keeping busy! This week in Science we are continuing to measure the weather. We have been using a thermometer to record daily temperatures. On Tuesday the children found out it was 10 degrees centigrade and on Thursday the temperature had dropped to 1 degree C. It has been chilly playing outside this week!

In maths we have started learning about 3D shapes, learning the names and sorting them according to different criteria. Which shapes can stack? have circle faces? It has been very hands on with children handling shapes, reasoning about them and making models.
