The children have enjoyed their R.E work about the Birth of Jesus and have been busy with Christmas Art and crafts (glitter time!)





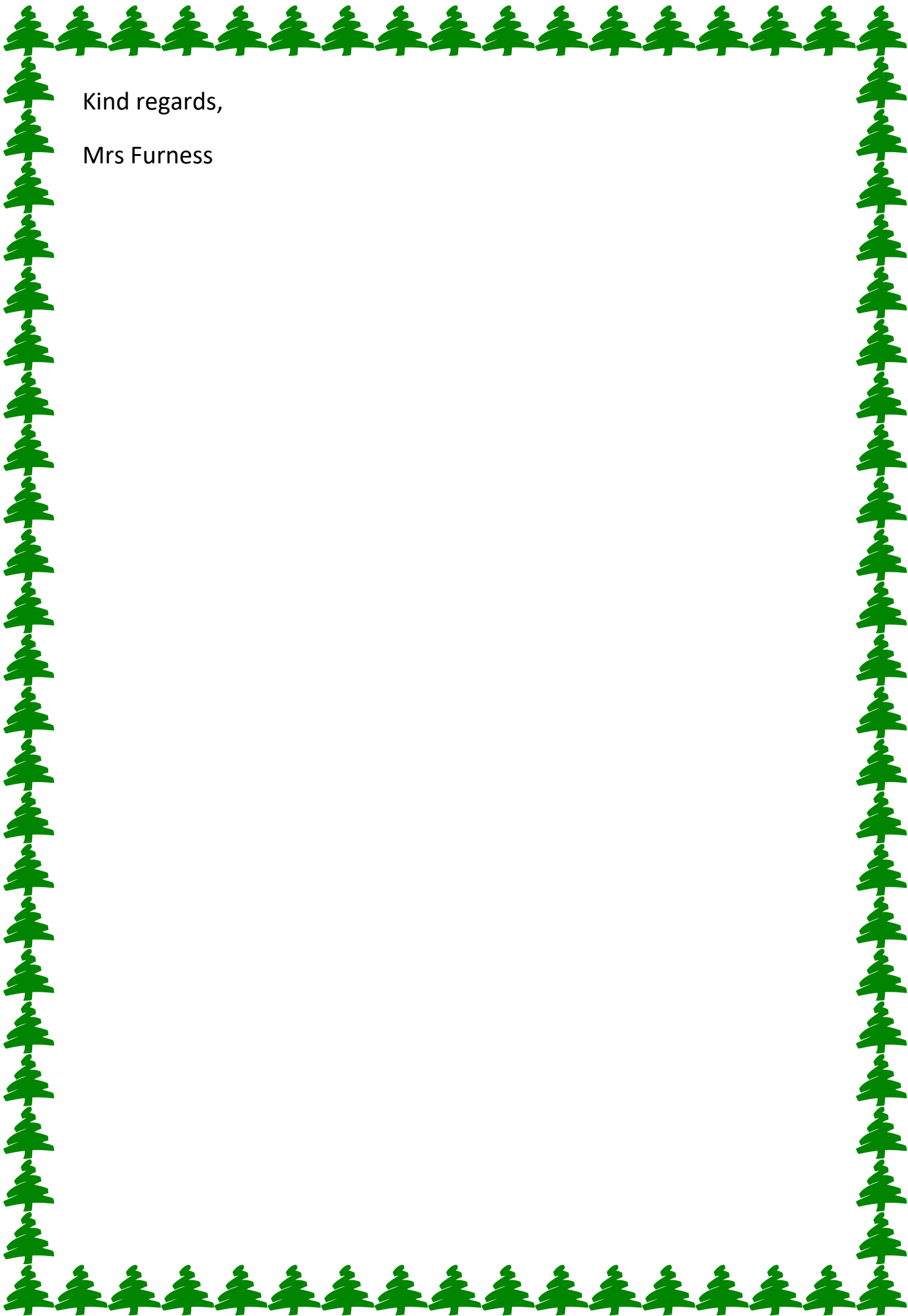
The children have also been working hard at writing some wonderful stories inspired by our class book 'Owl Babies'.
