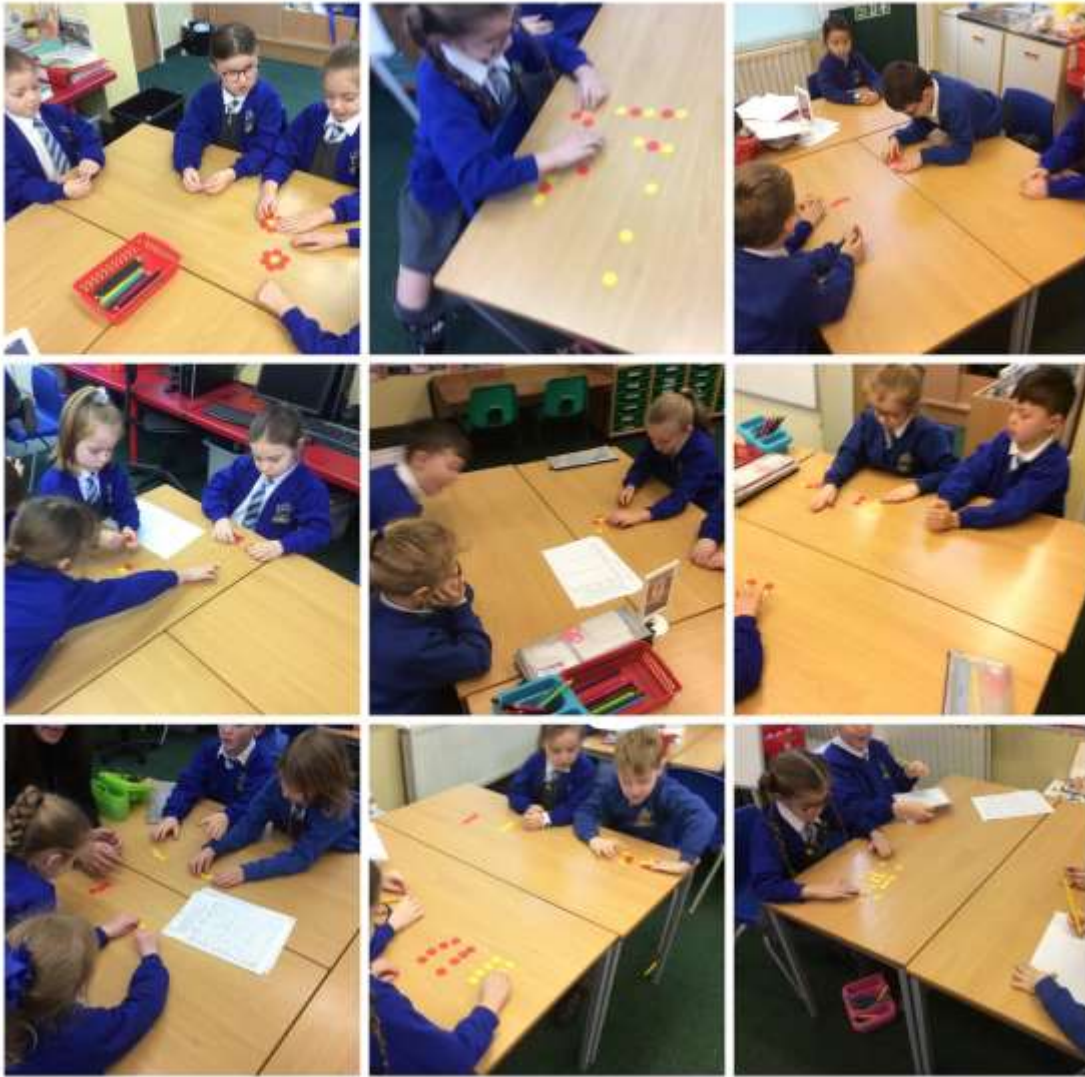
PE:

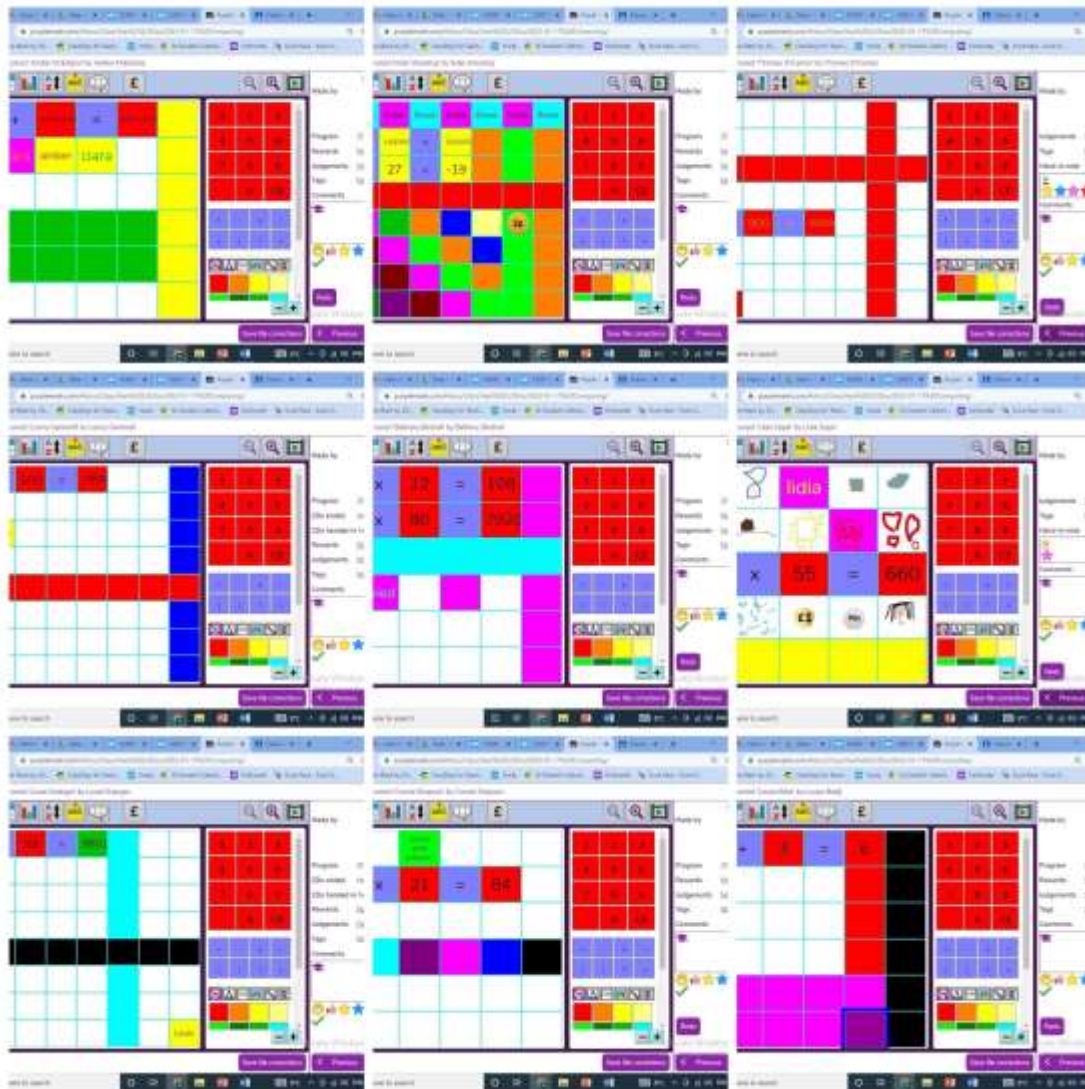
Music:
